

III. 20th WCNDT: Call for Exhibitions and Abstracts

On July 14th to the 16th, 2022 the Asian Welding Federation (AWF) held its 36th Governing Council Meeting and Committee Meetings in conjunction with the 75th International Institute of Welding (IIW) Annual Assembly and International Conference. While the IIW International Conference was held at the Tokyo Big Sight, in Tokyo Japan, the AWF held its meetings beforehand at the Japan Welding Engineering Society (JWES) headquarters in Tokyo, Japan.

The Malaysian Society for NDT (MSNT) has successfully organized the 6th Malaysia International NDT Conference and Exhibition (6th MINDTCE) on the 16th and 17th of August 2022. Albeit the concern on the pandemic, the two day event was visited by more than 1,000 visitors, seeing all 45 occupied booths and 55 presentations covering various



ASNT continues to work and implement its Strategic Plan (2022-2026). Plans are in motion to improve our certification portfolio. This includes launching ASNT 9712, expansion of the ISQ program, launching into regions outside of the US with specific offerings and pricing. Advocacy efforts are at the forefront and an NDT awareness campaign is underway. ASNT Foundation was formed and ASNT's research and scholarship programs will advance the body of knowledge and practice of NDT and increase awareness and interest in the field for researchers, teachers, and students by leading applied research and scholarship in the field.

Employer Based Certification program (EBC) is a registry of NDT Service Providers (Inspection Agencies, Laboratories, etc.) assessed by ASNT to ensure compliance with the requirements of either ASNT SNT-TC-1A or ANSI/ASNT CP-189, or both, through the Employers NDT Written Practice. Provides clients (existing and new) with the knowledge that the Registered Organization's employer-based personnel certification program(s) meets the intended document. EBC accreditation was designed to cut down on repetitive, redundant audits of the same records by multiple customers and regulatory agencies.

ASNT continues to grow its ISQ program. The hands-on qualification exams provide a common process and examination for testing nondestructive testing (NDT)

technicians. The practical exams assess the candidate's ability to perform the specific NDT technique on samples and product forms, as specified in the program protocol documents. These samples were designed and developed by the Oil & Gas industry.

Current exams include:

- Ultrasonic Thickness and Corrosion Scanning (UTT)
- Ultrasonic Shear Wave Weld Examination (UTSW).

Coming exams include:

- Ultrasonic Thickness Phased Array (UTPA),
- Ultrasonic Thickness Shear Wave (UTLS) for Pipeline Long Seam Welds and Magnetic Flux Leakage (MFL) Tank Floor Exam


